

# JESUS CHRIST: FILLING HEAVEN AND EARTH



We continue to examine the exaltation of Christ.


## **Between His Resurrection and Ascension**

## The Ascension of Christ, and Following

Read the accounts in Luke 24:50-51, and Acts 1:9-11. Continuing with His plan to make us his blessed servants, Jesus gave His disciples the work that they were to do. Then, as they watched, the very Man they had seen for 40 days after His resurrection began to rise up into the sky. The disciples watched until they could no longer see beyond the clouds. Then they noticed two angels standing with them. The angels told them that they would see Jesus when he came back again. He would come in the same way he went: in person, in His body. Who could ever have guessed God's wonderful plan to save mankind?
